Burial Plots—4' x 9'3 ½ ".....\$400.00

Interment fee\$50.00
(Full Burial or Burial of Ashes)

- ❖ one full burial per plot
- ❖ Vaults (liners) not required
- ❖ More than one cremated burial per plot (in addition to one full burial) is allowed
- ❖ A permanent grave stone is required within one year of any burial
- ❖ Gravestones may be any style and may be ordered through Premier Memorial of Tacoma
- ❖ All burials must be recorded with the secretary

GENERAL INFORMATION

- ❖ Please use plastic or metal containers for graveside flowers
- ❖ No glass containers allowed
- ❖ Artificial flowers must be removed when they become faded
- ❖ Pruning of trees and/or major landscaping projects must be approved by Board

Not far from Hales Passage on a quiet country road lies the Cromwell Cemetery.

It is a fitting resting place for the Scandinavian fishermen and their families who first settled the Cromwell area.

The Cemetery Association was first formed on January 3, 1903 and was originally called the "Hales Passage Scandinavian Lutheran Cemetery Association."

In the early years of its beginning only those of the Lutheran faith were interred there, but in the years since, other citizens of the Gig Harbor area have found it a final abiding place for their loved ones.

It was begun on donated land by Gabriel Evje and F. W. Samuelson.

Original members of the Cemetery Association were: F. W. Samuelson, Gus Carlson, Julius Berntsen, Rasmus Danielson and Gabriel Evje.
